Best Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc are picked and selected to be aged for 12 months in French oak barrels. Château Suau red wine will seduce you with its toasty, cocoa and vanilla aromas. Slightly oaked, you'll enjoy its full-bodied and silky mouth on its own, with red meat different all type of cheeses.



**Vineyard area :** 65 Hectares

**Soil type :** Gravely-clayey, exposure South- South-east

60% Merlot

40% Cabernet Sauvignon

**Average age of vines :** 23 years

**Vineyard management :** Double cordon of Royat

**Harvesting :** Hand picking or mechanised according different plots

**Wine making techniques :** Traditional in thermo-regulated stainless-steel vats

**Ageing :** In French oak barrels renewed by 1/3 every year
